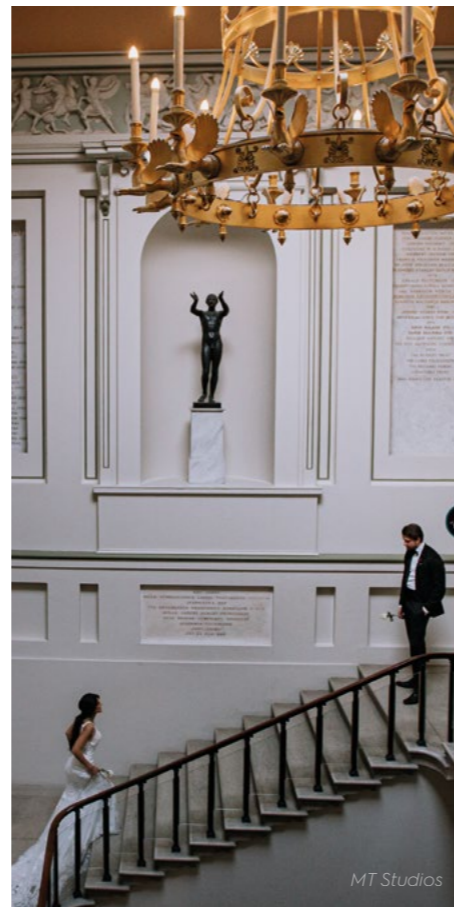

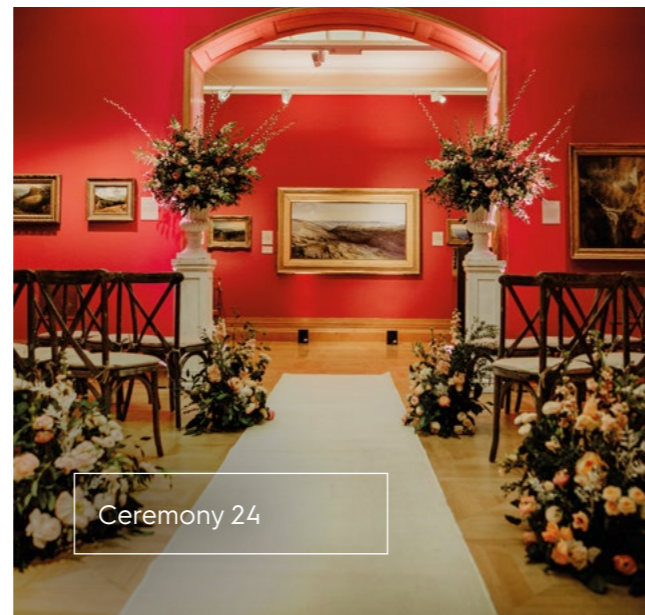

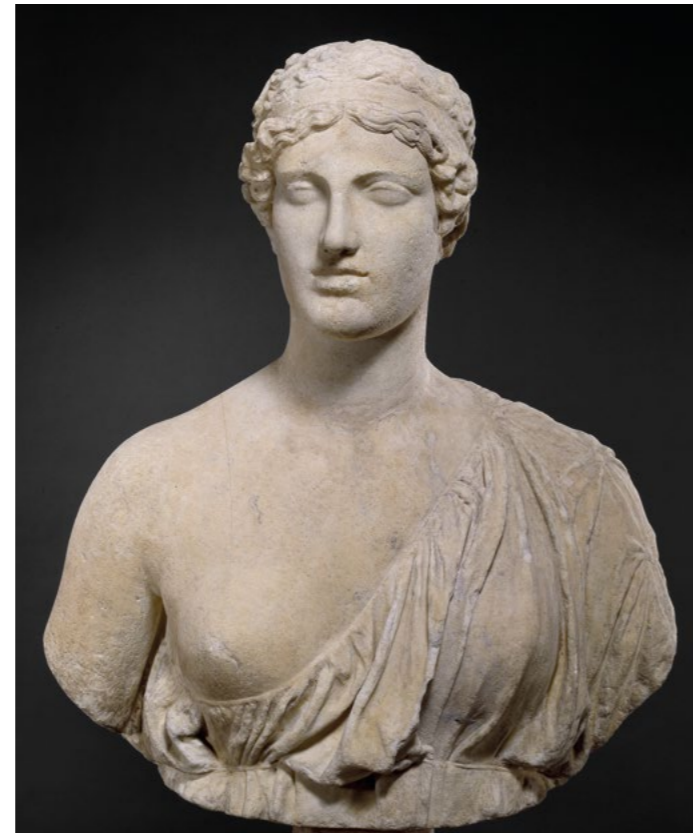

ROOFTOP DINING ROOM & OUTDOOR TERRACE

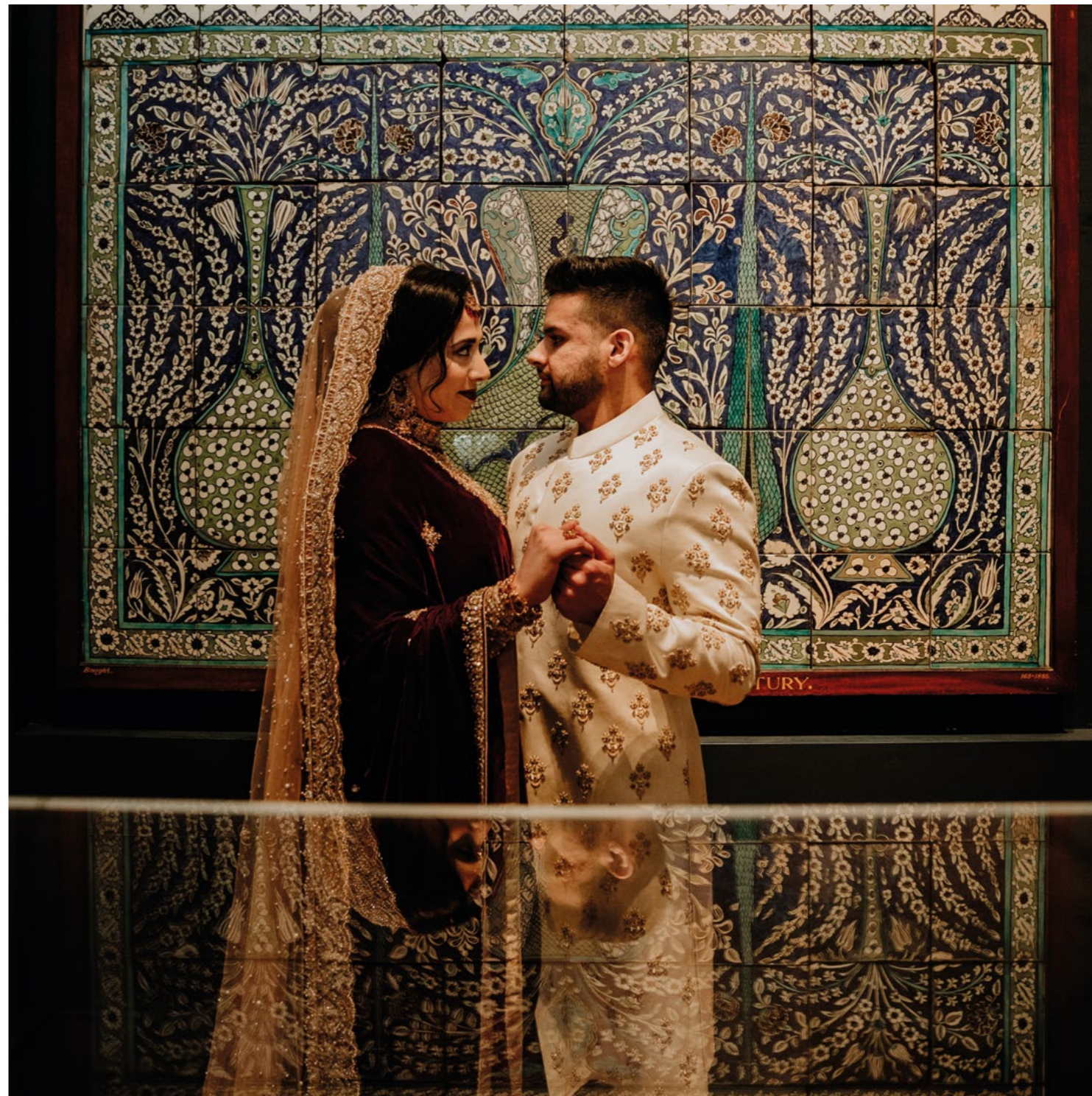

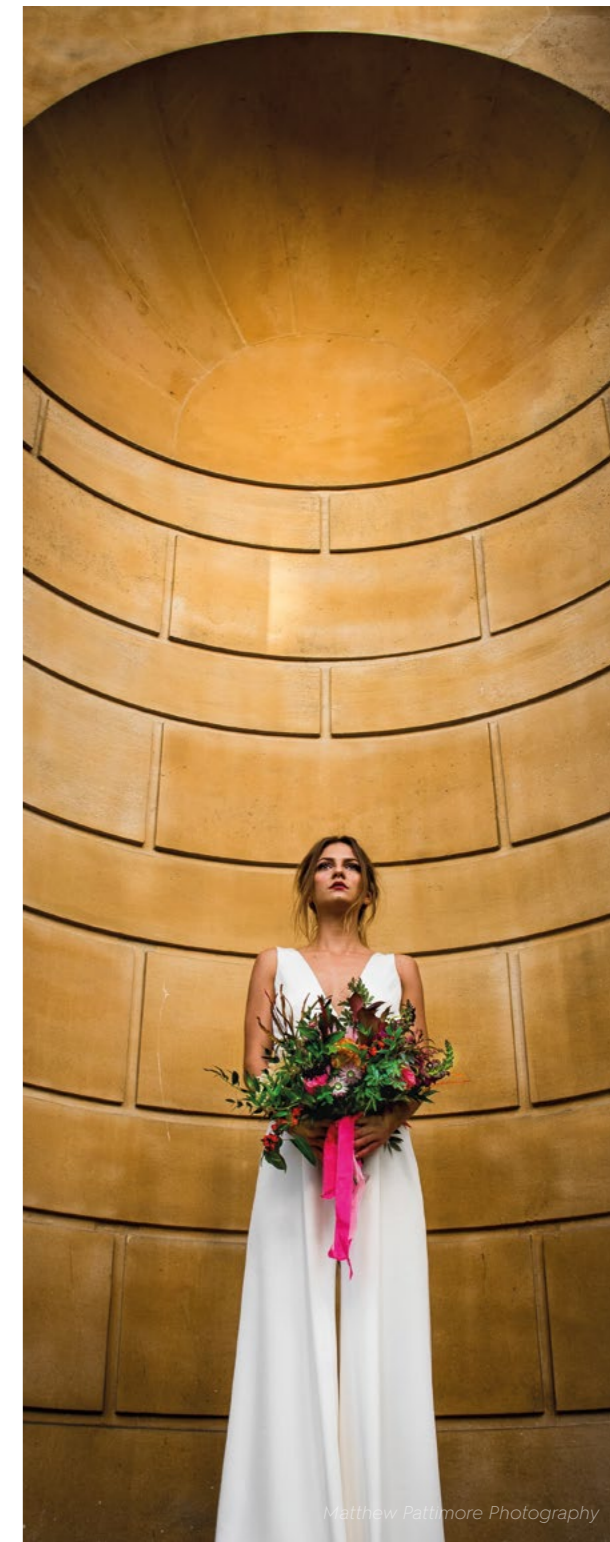

From 5.30pm the Museum is exclusively yours for the evening until midnight with an optional extension to 1am.

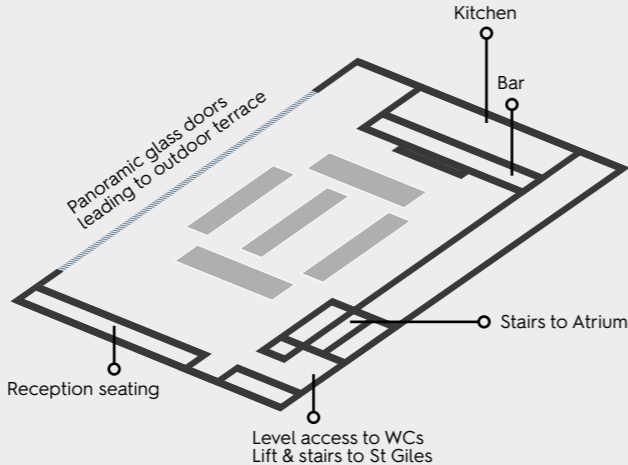
You may host your wedding reception in the Rooftop Dining Room in the daytime, or the evening and in the galleries **from 6.00pm** each evening.
